








London's Air Traffic Visualization






500-Millibar Height Contours at 7:00 A.M. E.S.T.








Frank Stella, Black Study I, 1968




Frank Stella, Double Gray Scramble, 1973




Sol LeWitt, Complex Forms with Lines in Four Directions, 1988















