

Rock 1



- Light brown rock
- Has a rough, grainy texture
- Contains unidentified fossils

Rock 2



- Shiny black rock
- Has high carbon content, over 90%

Rock 3



- White rock with bands of black
- Testing reveals large amounts of the mineral calcite, a form of calcium carbonate

Rock 4



- Reddish brown rock
- Contains many small, broken shells, cemented together by the mineral calcite
- Very soft, easily scratched

Rock 5



- Dark grey rock
- Hard rock, but breaks into thin, flat layers due to foliation (sheet-like structure)

Rock 6



- Black, white, and pink rock with large, crystalline grains
- Contains the minerals quartz and feldspar
